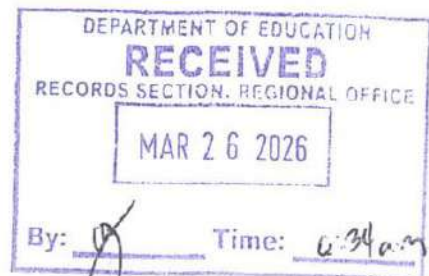

RDRRMC Response agencies must also maintain close coordination with local government units' Emergency Operations Centers and integrated into their Incident Management Team structure.

Furthermore, undertake usual situational monitoring and submit usual reports to the RDRRMOC in case of incidents and eventualities that may rise during the period of Holy Week.
