**GUIDELINES ON THE UTILIZATION OF DYNAMIC LEARNING PROGRAM (DLP)
LEARNING ACTIVITY SHEETS (LAS) DURING CLASS SUSPENSIONS DUE TO VOLCANIC
ACTIVITY AND OTHER CALAMITIES**

1. In view of the recent volcanic activity and the frequent suspension of classes due to natural calamities, this Office reiterates its commitment to ensuring learning continuity. Pursuant to **DepEd Order No. 022, s. 2024** and **DepEd Order No. 037, s. 2022**, all schools are directed to activate their **Learning and Service Continuity Plans (LSCP)** immediately.
2. To minimize instructional disruption, the **Dynamic Learning Program (DLP)** through its **Learning Activity Sheets (LAS)** shall be utilized for independent home-based learning during periods of class suspension.
3. School Heads shall abide with the following guidelines:
 - a. **Prepositioning of Learning Activity Sheets:** School Heads shall ensure that the printed copies of DLP-LAS (aligned with the current Quarter) are prepositioned and ready for immediate distribution.
 - b. **Distribution Mechanism:** In the event of an official class suspension, schools shall utilize established communication channels (e.g., GC groups, school FB pages, or community drop-points) to release the LAS.
 - c. **Learner Autonomy:** Following the DLP framework, learners are expected to engage in "learning by doing." They shall accomplish the LAS independently, focusing on the Concept Notes and Exercises provided.
 - d. **Teacher Monitoring:** Subject teachers must maintain a virtual monitoring log to track the progress of learners. Feedback shall be provided once classes resume or through available remote platforms.
4. As part of the initiatives of this Office to provide learning resources to affected learners of the recent volcanic activity, School Heads from the four (4) elementary schools namely Baligang ES, Amtic ES, Tambo ES and Buga ES are requested to claim the DLP-LASs for Grades 4-6 from the Curriculum Implementation Division-Learning Resources Management Section on **February 6, 2026**.



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5. Other elementary schools which are not provided with the hard copies, will be provided with the link or soft copy of the LASs for possible reproduction, while this Office is still looking for fund that could be used for that purpose.
6. The Public Schools District Supervisors shall monitor the distribution and utilization of the learning materials while the LRMS Personnel shall provide technical assistance in accessing the Division LR Portal for additional DLP-LAS resources.
7. For immediate dissemination, guidance and compliance.
