1. Pursuant to *DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2011 (Guidelines on the Implementation of the Learning Resources Management and Development System)* and *Republic Act No.10533 (Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013)*, which mandate strict quality assurance for locally developed learning materials, the Curriculum Implementation Division through the ALS in-charge of the program will conduct the *Phase 2 Quality Assurance and Final Validation of ALS Contextualized Session Guides* on *Sept.3, 2026* at St. Elmo's Event Hall, Batang Ligao City.
2. This training workshop aims to:
 - a. **Validate Pedagogical Alignment:** Ensure session guides strictly adhere to DepEd-ALS curriculum standards, learning competencies, and instructional strategies.
 - b. **Contextualization and Cultural Sensitivity:** Evaluate whether local context, language, and cultural elements are appropriately and respectfully integrated.
 - c. **Assess Operational Usability:** Determine the practical feasibility of using the session guides in community learning centers.
 - d. **Finalize Material Readiness:** Final LRMDs quality assurance to make the session guides ready for printing, pilot testing on division-wide rollout.



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3. The participants to this activity are: EPSs, PSDSs/ALS focal person, 2 EPSA,PDO and Division Librarian who will serve as technical provider and resource speakers, additionally 20 ALS Teachers and 14 CAIs. 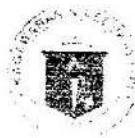
