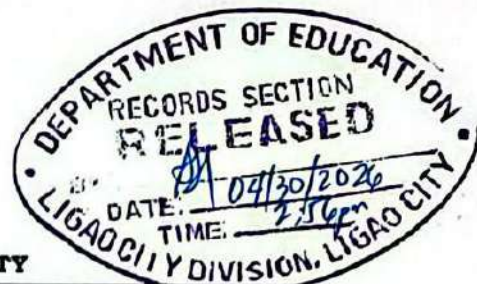

FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027**

1. To provide baseline data on the Out-of-School Children/Youth and Adults (OSCYA) in the communities and to ensure that appropriate interventions and support mechanisms are suited to the learners' needs and contexts, the Schools Division Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division-Alternative Learning System, will conduct the **Advocacy and Social Mobilization and Literacy Mapping for School Year 2026-2027** under Project ALS MAP (Mapping, Advocacy and Partnership) on May 4-29, 2026.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. update the previous ALS Literacy Mapping database of the 55 covered barangays;
 - b. encourage qualified mapped learners to enroll in the program;
 - c. strengthen partnerships between barangay officials, NGOs, and other local stakeholders for the sustainability of the program.
3. The ALS Teachers and Community ALS Implementers (CAIs) will conduct the literacy mapping in their respective assigned barangays. At the same time, the Division ALS Focal Person and Education Program Specialist II-ALS will monitor and provide technical assistance on the conduct of the activity.
4. All literacy mapping results shall be uploaded on the Google Drive link <https://bit.ly/als-lit-map2026> on or before **June 5, 2026**.
5. Enclosed in this memorandum is the Assignment of ALS implementers.
6. ALS teachers who shall render services relative to this activity shall be granted service credits in accordance with the provisions of DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024.
7. To effectively plan and prepare for this activity, a division conference will be conducted on May 4, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. at the ALS Building, LWCES (B) Compound, Binatagan, Ligao City.
