**CALL FOR PARTICIPANTS TO THE ARAL SERIES: A MASTER CLASS ON
EXECUTIVE FUNCTIONING FOR REMEDIATION**

1. Pursuant to Section 4 of the Republic Act (RA) No. 12028, or the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program Act of 2024, and DepEd Order 18, s. 2025, or the Implementing Guidelines of the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning Program, the Department of Education implemented the ARAL Program to establish a free and effective National Learning Intervention Program to ensure that all learners who are struggling in their lessons, especially in reading, mathematics, and science, will be able to attain the competencies set by DepEd in their respective levels.

In line with this commitment, the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), in partnership with the Gokongwei Brothers Foundation (GBF), shall conduct the upcoming installment of the ARAL Series entitled ARAL Series: Master Class on Executive Functioning for Remediation, via Microsoft Teams Townhall on **June 27, July 4, and July 11, 2026**.
